The whole waste is segregated that can be used for composting which is dumped for vermi-composting. Our gardeners and sweepers help in the process of segregation of waste. Students are also used separate waste tank. Routine wise its' daily collection from dustbin at different location of college. Segregated into different types of bio and non bio degradable of waste and taken to the dumping spot. Regular cleaning operations are organized by college NSS unit .The entire campus of the college is a 'PLASTIC FREE ZONE'. The institution discourages plastic use in the campus.

- Separate waste bins are used for degradable and non degradable waste.
- We have given importance on digitaization in most of the office work via mail,whatsapp etc.

In the campus of Chatra Ramai Pandit Mahavidyalaya ground water is stored into the tanks after drawing it from underground. A number of water tanks are installed on the roofs of our college building from where water is supplied to various parts of the college through well designed and standard pipe network system .Drinking water is supplied to suitable place after purifying it through another set of high quality pipelines,Besides there a few water purifiers are installed in our college campus to meet the demand of the safe drinking water and to ensure flawless ,smooth distribution of drinking water to all.Beside there is also a tube well in our college campus which is also used in different purpose. The college authority is also conscious enough in any kind of wastage of a single drop of purified drinking water . The authority makes the students aware of the value of a single drop of water and necessity of the conservation of water,a great treasure.In fact they are made conscious about the value of a drop of water and to close the tap after its proper usage.

The rainwater is discharged into a nearby pond through sound drainage systems from the beginning of our college. This pond water is used for the irrigation purposes.The cultivators of local area are very much benefitted for such a planned water conservation .

4. GREEN CAMPUS INITIATIVES

Chatra Ramai Pandit Mahavidyalaya is well known for its greenery. The college has a various types of trees and has a banquet garden which are very essential and play very vital role present situation. ii) Use of bicycle:- A good number of students use bicycles to reach the campus. Students and some staff coming from nearby villages prefer bicycle as a mode of transport for attending the college. Rest of the students uses pedestrian friendly paths to reach college campus. It is environment friendly and prevents pollution. A large number of faculty, non teaching staff and students of the institution use public transport. Specific parking area is allotted for faculty and students.

III) Ban on use plastic:- In college campus single plastic items are banned completely and awareness is created among staff and students through display boards in the premises. The use of plastic tea cups and water bottle is prohibited in the college. Sufficient dustbins are placed in the appropriate places to make campus neat and clean.

IV) Use of led :- LED bulbs and tube lights only used in college. Majority of the classrooms, administrative office, Library and seminar hall and staff room were provided with led lighting system which are supposed to be the energy efficient.

v) Plantation of tree:- The institute has a canopy of trees and plants to make the environment pollution free.
